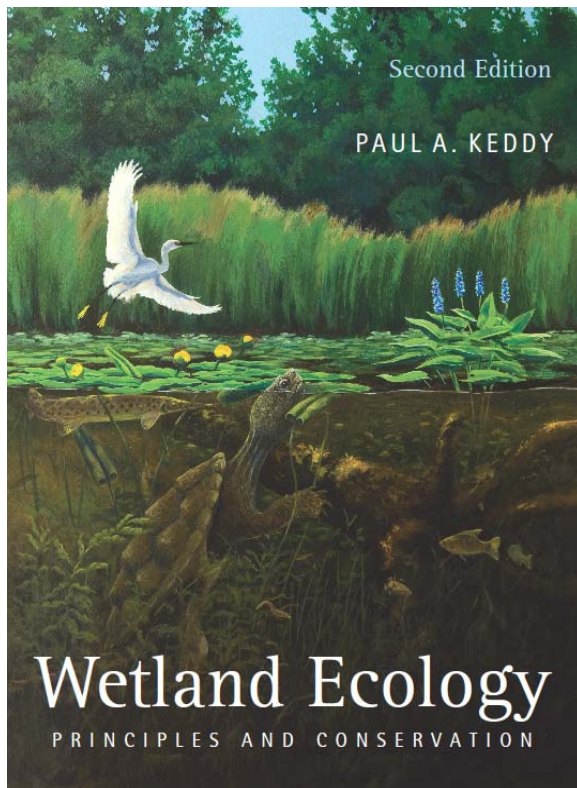


# Science in the Service of Wetland Conservation: Advances, Retreats, Opportunities
